Brief Description of the Position:

Position Requirements:

- BS in Safety, Industrial Hygiene, Environmental Science, or similar field; or other technical degree with appropriate work experience
- Working knowledge of regulatory standards (i.e. – OSHA, EPA/TCEQ, and RCRA)
